It has been over 15 years since the last public air show at Lynchburg Regional Airport (LYH). Accordingly, Virginia Aviation would like to recommend to the Airport Commission that a plan be put in place to establish an annual event open to the general public. This event would include airline, general aviation and military participation. The primary purpose would be to showcase the many activities of the airport.

The major participants in this air show would likely be Delta, US AIR, Falwell Aviation, Liberty University Flight Department, the Virginia Department of Aviation, the EAA from Farmville, Cessna Aircraft Company, Precision Windsports, Virginia Aviation and, of course, Lynchburg Regional Airport.


With careful planning, the air show could be close to revenue neutral. The City could collect a parking fee for automobiles and would receive 16 cents a gallon under current contracts from the fuel sales generated by the sale of Aviation fuels to aircraft participating in the air show.
